To become an ISA Qualified Surf Coach a surfer must hold a valid Beach Lifeguard Qualification and must attend and pass an ISA Surf Coach Course. ISA Level 1 Surf Coaches are qualified to coach novice to intermediate surfers. ISA Level 2 Surf Coaches are qualified to coach intermediate to advanced surfers.

Following the course a surfer must complete 30 hours coaching experience, a log of which must be returned to the ISA along with two passport size photographs at which stage a coaches card and confirmation of qualification will be issued.

To revalidate a Coaching Qualification a surfer must renew their beach lifeguard qualification and forward a copy of their certificate to the ISA.
