The course, which will be held in Midleton, Co. Cork, is organised over 1 day and will be non-residential. Accommodation is available locally if desired, and information will be sent on request to all Course Attendees with detailed joining instructions.

The course fee has been set at €150 per person. As demand is likely to exceed the maximum number of places on the course, early application is strongly recommended, using the attached application form.

The Course is Modular and will cover the key skills and tasks relating to the training and assessing of Pool Lifeguards.

Candidates will be continually assessed throughout the course and will be encouraged to develop their existing training skills through Group Exercises and the presentation of training sessions.
